The class focuses on the close reading of non-fiction texts with an emphasis on analyzing the choices an author makes in order to convey meaning and formulate a strong argument. Through guided instruction, students with a strong background in reading will be introduced to the value of looking at word choice in identifying the reasons writers make specific choices; this skill ultimately leads to a richer understanding of the text as a whole.

This course is recommended for students who are moving into Freshmen Honors English for 2026-27 and who want to cultivate critical thinking skills.
